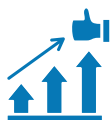
Sub-Saharan Africa as a Gateway to LPG Opportunities in Africa

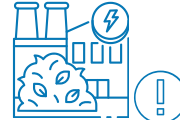

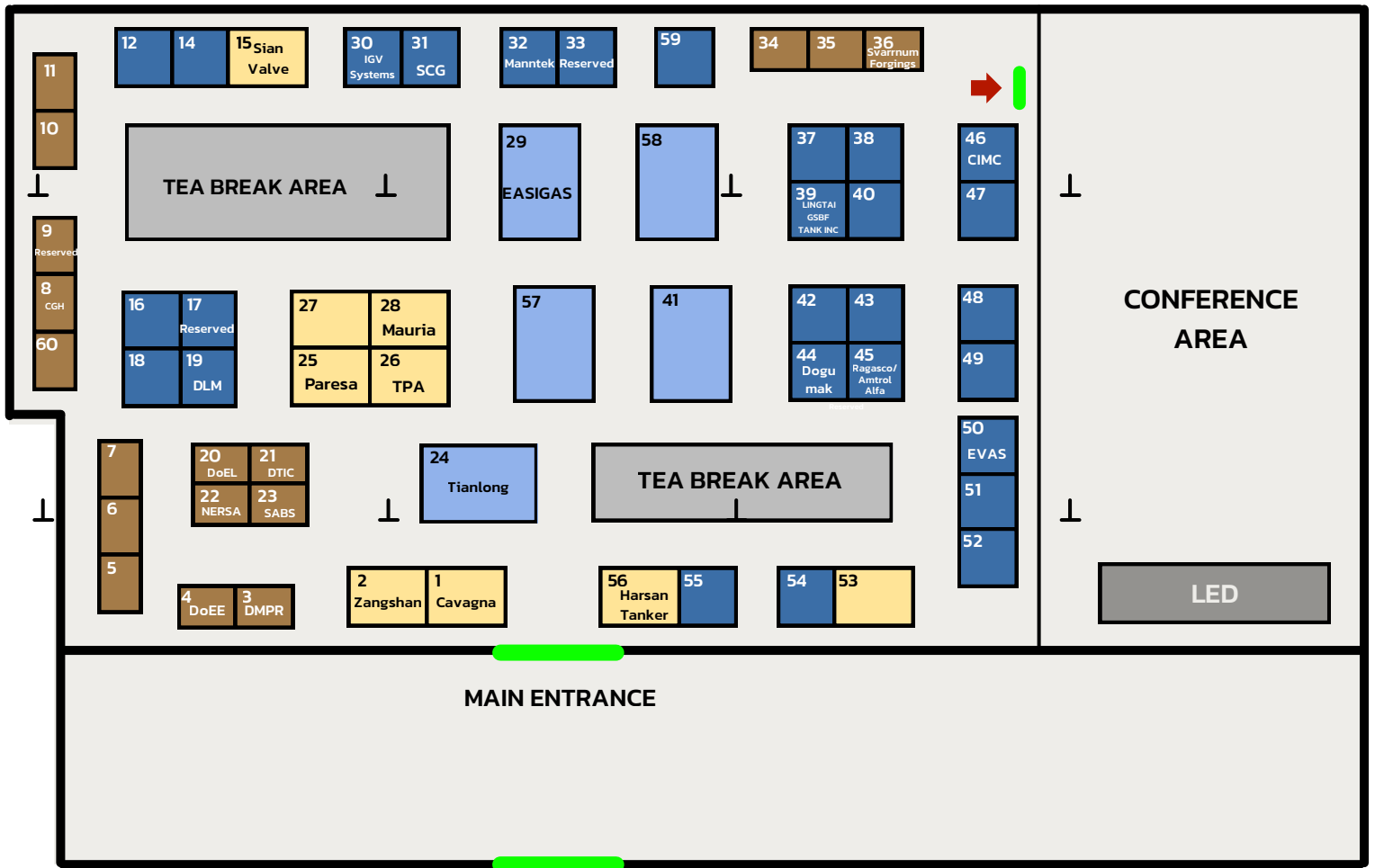
