



1. Terms and conditions for the LPGSA Bursary for LPG Residential Installation Course competition

- 4.3.2 A PowerPoint Presentation in English with no more than 20 slides.
- 4.3.3 You will be required to deliver your presentation to selection panel (in person or virtually).

4.4 Additional documents,

- 4.4.1 A certified copy of the entrant's SA ID
- 4.4.2 A certified copy of at least the entrant's school or TVET results on the school's letterhead.
- 4.4.3 Contactable telephone numbers or email address.



5. The Competition closes on 30th October 2026. After this date no further entries to the competition will be permitted.
